Make Tee Time Reservations ahead of time. Check the club website for more information, including attire requirements. Pack your sunscreen, hat, visor, sunglasses, water, and bug spray.

April and May are prime seasons for Gator mating. During mating season, Gators are moving in search of a mate. They tend to become more aggressive. Most Florida golf clubs and courses will have at least one Gator in the lake and/or water hazards. **Feeding gators is illegal.** If you bring a child, keep them away from all lakes and water hazards.
